



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CAN I ENTER JOE'S JOG ONLINE?

Yes, just fill out the online booking form and register today

WILL I BE ABLE TO ENTER ON THE NIGHT OF THE RACE?

Yes, providing the run is not over-subscribed. The prices for the pm registration period is **£6 per child and £10 per adult.

****PLEASE NOTE: WE CAN ONLY ACCEPT CASH PAYMENTS on the night of the run.**

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE FOR ENTERING JOE'S JOG 2024?

You can enter up until 6pm on race day by completing an entry form at the registration point at the Rothley Centre between 5.15 pm and 6pm.

HOW DO I KNOW MY ONLINE ENTRY HAS BEEN RECEIVED?

When entering online you will automatically receive a confirmation email.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY RUN PACK?

No run packs are sent out, they are to be collected from the registration area in the Rothley Centre on the night.

ARE THERE ANY AGE RESTRICTIONS?

No age restrictions, we only advise that where Juniors are running without parental supervision (entering without an adult) they should be 7 years or older.

Although the race is called Joe's Jog, families of all ages are welcome to run/walk the course and even bring small children in buggies etc.

Parents are responsible for their children at all times.

START TIME AND LOCATION

The run begins at 18.15 (15 minutes past 6pm). The Rothley Centre will be open from 5.15 pm on the evening of the race.

WHERE DOES THE RACE BEGIN?

The race will start on Woodgate underneath the inflatable start/finish gantry.

WHERE CAN RUNNERS PARK THEIR CARS DURING THE RACE?

Car parking locations are very limited but there will be some spaces available at the Rothley Centre, Rothley Court and Fowke Street Playing Fields. **Please do not park on the streets where it will cause an obstruction.**

IS THERE A SAFE PLACE THAT RUNNERS CAN LEAVE ANY VALUABLES WHILST TAKING PART IN THE RACE?

There is no facility available to store any valuables whilst taking part in the race and would suggest that you leave these items at home prior to attending the race.

WILL THERE BE FIRST AID STATIONS AROUND THE COURSE?

There will be two separate paramedic teams on the day of the race.

ARE THERE WATER STATIONS ALONG THE ROUTE?

There will be a water station at the finish line.

WHEN WILL THE RESULTS OF THE RACE BE AVAILABLE?

This is a fun run so times will not be recorded other than for the first 3 people to complete the run.

IS THE RUN CHIP-TIMED?

No this is a fun run so times will not be recorded other than for the first 3 people to complete the run.

ARE HEADPHONES ALLOWED?

No; under health and safety grounds.

MEDALS

You will receive a medal for completing the race. Water will be available at the end of the run.
